Election Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Election Day: The 2026 Primary Election will take place on Tue, June 30, 2026. • Ballots Sent 6/8: Ballots will be mailed on Mon, June 8 and should arrive over the course of the following week.
Returning Ballots	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ballot Box: Ballots should be returned to the ballot box (recently moved to the SW corner of the parking lot). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Do not direct people to return their ballots to our Office. ○ All ballot boxes are open 24 / 7 until 7 pm on Election Day. ○ Other ballot boxes are located all over Fort Collins and Larimer County. ○ Find a full list at larimer.gov/where-to-vote.
Voter Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Before June 22: Voters can update their registration, obtain a replacement ballot, or receive other service at our Office on the 5th Floor. • On or after June 22: Voters should be directed to the vote center on the 1st Floor. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Voters can also update their registration online at GoVoteColorado.gov.
Vote Centers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LCAS Opens 6/22: Voters can also return their ballot at the vote center on the first floor of the building starting Monday, June 22.
Other Key Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Last Day to Mail Ballots: The last day voters should return ballots by mail is Mon, June 22. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ After that, they should take their ballots to a ballot box or vote center.
